



Friendly Reminder from the Fontana Police Department

The Fontana Police Department has received numerous complaints from parents/motorists reference traffic violations at or near D.W. Long Elementary. The traffic violations are primarily committed at the beginning and ending of school hours. The following are some of the complaints we have received by residents and motorist; in addition, officers have conducted patrols and have witnessed the complaints reported by the public.

- Driving northbound on Bridlepath Dr. in the southbound lane (*VC 21650*).
- Stopping a vehicle on Bridlepath Dr. at the south driveway, waiting to enter the school parking lot. This causes cars to back up southbound towards Cherry Ave (*22400 a*).
- Making a left turn from southbound Bridlepath Dr. to enter the north or south driveways. These turns are prohibited by two separate signs indicating no left turns, with specific time restrictions (*VC 21461 a*).
- Making a left turn from the north driveway to continue southbound on Bridlepath Dr. A posted sign at the driveway indicates no left turns, with time restrictions (*VC 21461 a*).
- Stopping on Bridlepath Dr along a curb with signs indicating **NO STOPPING**. (*VC 21461 a*).

Driving Record: These violations are considered moving violations and will result in 1 point accessed to your driving record, if convicted.

Possible minimum fines: \$234

The Etiwanda School District and the Fontana Police Department understand there is limited parking on Bridlepath Dr and in the school's parking lot. Unfortunately not everybody will be able to pick up or drop off their child inside the school's parking lot. Parents are encouraged to park in the surrounding side streets and utilize marked crosswalks while escorting children to and from the school. Please obey the crossing guards who are present to provide additional safety for parents, school children and motorist.

The Fontana Police Department maintains that public education and awareness is a key factor in promoting traffic safety. We encourage the public to set the example by obeying traffic laws, thus making the area safer for our school children.
